



Webinar 23 June 2026: Preparing your company for the Cbw (Cybersecurity Act)

MVO - The Netherlands Oils and Fats Industry, together with the Netherlands Oils, Fats and Oilseeds Trade Association, the European Groundnut Association and the Royal Dutch Grain and Feed Trade Association, invites you to a webinar on the upcoming Dutch Cybersecurity Act (derived from Network and Information Security Directive, NIS2) and its impact on the food and feed supply chain. The webinar will take place on 23 June 2026 from 15:00 to 16:30 CEST.

With the entry into force expected in the second half of 2026, Cbw will significantly change how companies need to manage cyber risks, organise responsibilities and ensure business continuity. While awareness of the legislation is growing, many companies are still uncertain about what this means in practice. This webinar aims to provide clarity on the implications of Cbw and what companies need to implement in the coming period.

During the webinar, a representative from the **NCSC (Het Nationaal Cyber Security Centrum)** will outline where companies can find practical support, including available tools, guidance and points of contact for questions related to implementation.

In addition, the **Netherlands Food and Consumer Product Safety Authority (NVWA)** will explain how supervision under Cbw will take place in practice. What can companies expect from inspections and audits? How will compliance be assessed? And how will the NVWA approach its role in strengthening cyber resilience across the sector?

Finally, a **food producing company**, which already has progression on implementing Cbw requirements, will share its experiences, offering practical insights into challenges, decisions and lessons learned.

Programme

During the session, we will address key topics such as:

- What does Cbw mean for your company?
- Does your company fall within scope?
- What can you expect from enforcement?
- Where can you turn to for support and guidance?

This webinar (in English) is relevant for both large and smaller companies across the oilseeds and fats, grains and groundnut sector. It is particularly valuable for organisations seeking a clearer understanding of their position and the steps they will need to take. Participants will leave with a clear overview of the obligations ahead, a better understanding of the supervisory approach, and insight into where to find the right support to move forward.
